

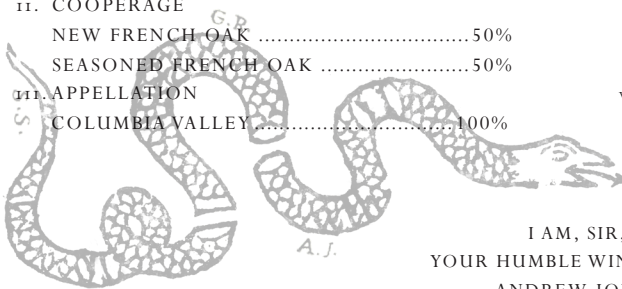
BARTER & TRADE
